

RELATING ROMANS 15:13 WITH HEBREWS 11:1 REGARDING FAITH AND HOPE (Abbreviated form)

Romans 15:13 New King James Version (paraphrased)

<sup>13</sup> Now may the God of hope, make you full with all joy and peace, as you believe in God

hope- a Divine guarantee  
-confident expectation  
-positive certainty

The measure of joy and peace that hope is giving you faith to receive.

The amount of joy and peace that is included in the promise of this scripture.

,Who gives you superabundance of hope by the miracle power of the Holy Spirit. [end of v13]

This is the goal for hope to reach

to believe in

To hold as the object of faith; God this case!

This is the process of producing faith to act upon the force of joy and force of peace.

Hebrews 11:1 KJV

Now faith is the substance of things (hoped for) the evidence of things not seen.

This is active faith in present tense. Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Rhema Word of God. (Rhema is a spoken Faith filled Word of God).

In this case, substance is "with all joy and peace". It is that in which the real nature of something consists. It is the final product that faith produces, it is a result of hope and faith is impossible without hope.

of things (that God has given a Divine Guarantee for)  
of things (that God has given us confident expectation for)  
of things (that God has made to be a positive certainty for)  
This hope is produced by the explosive strength, ability and miraculous power of the Holy Spirit.

Hope means that we must trust and wait for what is still unseen. Faith comprehends as fact what cannot be experienced by the physical senses.

Doubt sees what currently is and no more. Hope sees what can be but is not yet. Faith sees what is and what will be.
